Meanwhile, neighbouring Anafiotika is stuck in a previous century, carved into the northeast side of the hill of the Acropolis and with tiny white houses that look like they have been lifted from the Cyclades.
- ✓ **Best of all, Athens is a city that doesn't sleep, so you can carry on the fun as long into the night as you want.** It's worth booking a table or you can just leave it to chance and bar hop. All the downtown neighbourhoods are within walking distance. There are even experience providers that can put together a night out at some of Athens' best bars.

For digital nomads, Paros offers an intoxicating change of pace.

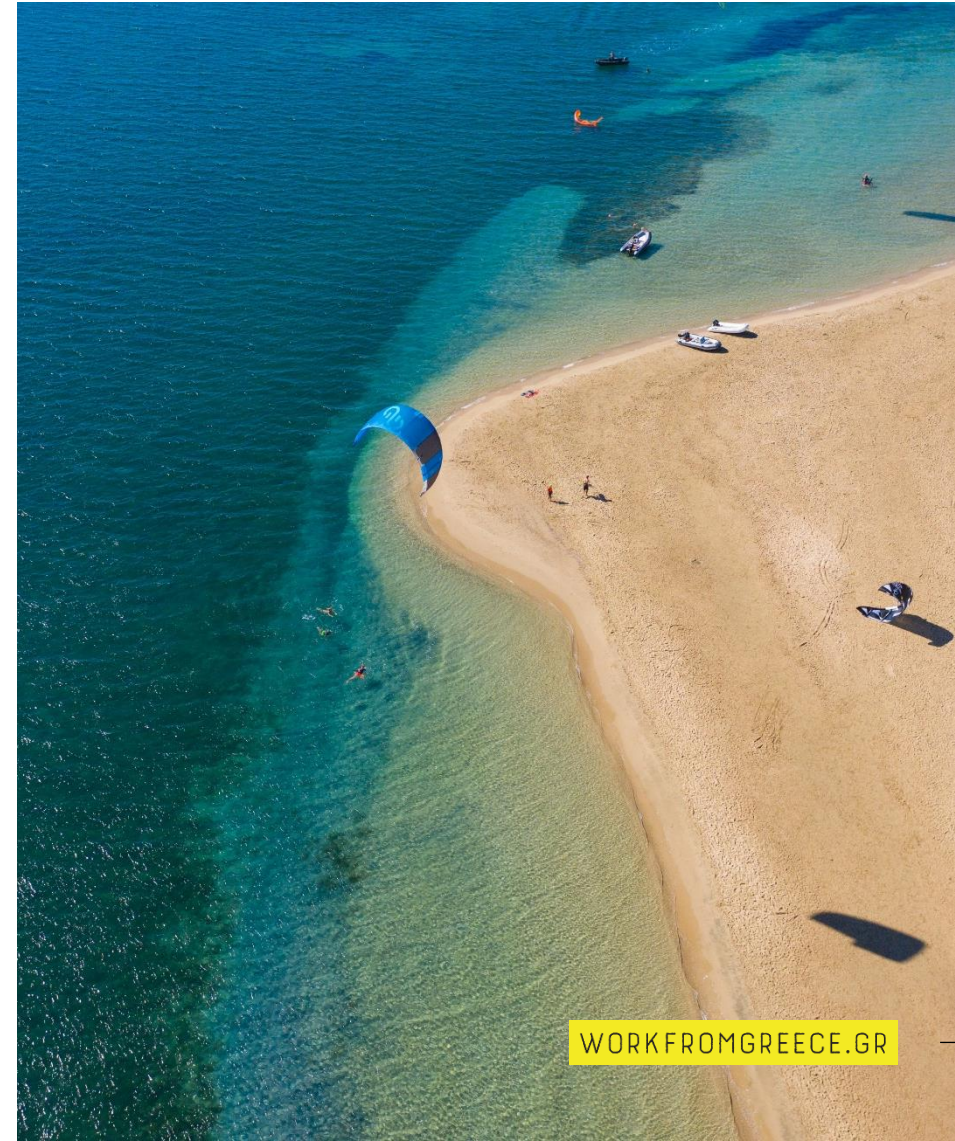
Discover all the unique things to do in Paros

Don't miss the opportunity to catch it between two of Mt Pelion's most picturesque villages, Lehonía and Milies.
- ✓ **Hiking on the mountain of mythical Centaurs:** Pelion was and is a living mountain, with a dense network of trails and paths. Experienced hikers and nature lovers will adore exploring the mountain's secrets and rich vegetation. Keep an eye out for the legendary half-human, half-horse Centaurs who reside(d) here.
